DIRECTIONS to Robert Frost Interpretive Trail...

From Middlebury VT, travel south on Route 7 to where it intersects with Route 125. Travel east on Route 125 for 5.8 miles. The parking area is on the right. Short walk to meeting.

From Rochester VT, travel north on Route 100 to its intersection with Route 125. Travel west on Route 125 for 14 miles. The parking area is on the left. Short walk to meeting.

DIRECTIONS to Ripton Community House...

From Robert Frost Interpretive Trail, travel 2 miles west on Route 125 to village of Ripton. Community House is on the right in the village.

From Middlebury VT, travel south on Route 7 to where it intersects with Route 125. Travel 3.8 miles east on Route 125 to village of Ripton. Community House is on the left in the village.

From Rochester VT, travel north on Route 100 to its intersection with Route 125. Travel 16 miles west on Route 125 to village of Ripton. Community House is on the right in the village.

Parking: 30 – 40 cars in front of Community House and Town Office. No parking is allowed in the Chipman Inn lot next door, or on the lawn.
